Health

We understand that all students MUST be immunized and a record must be on file to attend. We will sign a Community Health Commitment and have one per family on file prior to the first day of school.

We will not send our child to school within 24 hours of a fever over 99 degrees, vomiting or diarrhea. We will send our child in good health ready to participate in all activities, including outside play. We will report to the school any known exposure to communicable diseases.

We give SFDS our permission in an emergency to obtain the medical services of a physician for which we will assume financial responsibility.

We will advise the teacher and school of any dietary, environmental, seasonal or insect allergies or any other medical condition our child may have. If our child suffers from a known allergy or condition which may require medical care, we will have an Emergency Medical Plan on file before the first day of school. Teachers or staff members are not allowed to administer medication during the school day unless an Authorization of Prescription Medication form signed by the prescribing physician is on file.

We understand we are enrolling our child in an allergy sensitive school and will not knowingly send in food products that could be cross-contaminated or are made with or in a facility that manufactures nut products.

We understand and agree that St. Francis Episcopal Church, SFDS, administrators, teachers, staff, volunteers and associates are hereby released of from any claims, or financial responsibility arising out of any injury that may occur in connection with the operation of the school, or from any illness that may be contracted by my child during the period of enrollment.

Photo Consent

We consent and allow our child to be filmed, videotaped and/or photographed for use by SFDS. We also allow our child's work product to be featured and/or used by the school or the St. Francis Episcopal Church website.

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Enrollment and Financial Responsibility

The enrollment of our child is a contract between our family and St. Francis Day School. We plan to enroll our child for the entire school year and agree to this financial commitment. If we move out of Guilford County or need to withdraw for any other reason, we will notify the school in writing four weeks prior to the withdrawal date. **Tuition accrues regardless of attendance.** We, the undersigned parent or legal guardian, accepts responsibility for payment of tuition.

We understand that if a tuition refund is due, it will be mailed to our new address and registration fees are not refundable.

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Tuition

We understand the May 2022 tuition is payable on or before May 10, 2021. The September 2021 through April 2022 tuition is due on the first of each month. Tuition is considered past due after the 10th of each month. A \$20.00 late fee will be due for all tuition received after the 10th. A returned check fee of \$25.00 will be due for any check returned to the school. We will speak with the director if we are having financial difficulties.

Class Assignment

“Please be aware that teacher positions are based upon enrollment. Parents may request a particular teacher, but no guarantee can be made. The director will balance the classes by size, gender and school readiness. It is best to talk to your child about getting ready for school in general terms. Please do not reference a teacher’s name, a particular classroom or friends that you assume will be in the class.” ~ *The Parent Handbook, page 4*
